



Demolition Derby Championship Series Guidelines

To encourage participation in demolition derbies, KAFHS has created a high point series to recognize and reward such participation.

County Fairs wishing to participate in this program must complete a Motorsport's membership form and pay a \$50 fee prior to the event. The event, Demolition Derby must be a featured part of the Fair.

Participants shall be awarded points in the following manner when entered in a participating County Fair program:

20	Points to participate in a derby
10	Points to participate in the feature,
15	Points for winning the feature,
10	Points for 2 nd place in the feature,
5	Points for 3 rd place in the feature.

Each participating Fair must file an official report and the participant list form following the event. Any issues that might occur with the points supplied by the official report are the responsibility of the local Fair & the participant to correct, prior to submission to Reva. These forms can be found via Reva Mitchell or the web site, KAFS.net. These forms must be filed with Reva Mitchell via Certified mail within 30 days of the event. Please adhere to requested information request on forms for proper information needs. This is for accurate accumulation of points per individual participant via the multiple fairs that they may participate in the point series.

At the end of the County Fair season, all reported points will be tallied and a 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place shall be determined. Those winners will be invited to the Association's annual convention where they will receive trophies and the following prize money during the Business Meeting:

\$1000	First Place
\$ 500	Second Place
\$ 300	Third Place

There would be one entity per county recognized as a participant in this program. The County Fair is the entity to be recognized.

Points will be counted for derbies held in the fair week only. If there are multiple derbies held during the fair week, then points will be summarized for each driver. This would be on the dates turned in as fair weeks. Rain dates will be accepted, if held within 30 days of the fair.

Results will be summarized by Members of the Motorsports Committee prior to the January Convention.
